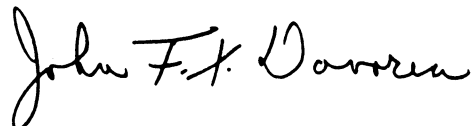

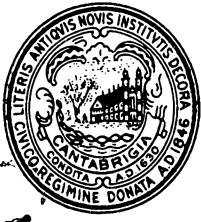
1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

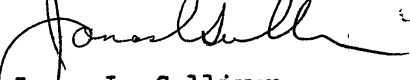
