

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, October 4th 1871

Whereas, it is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that Franklin Street from Pleasant Street to Putnam Street should be laid out and widened. Ordered, That a strip upon either side of said Street included between the red lines as shown on a plan drawn by W^o S Barbour Civil Engineer and dated May 23^d 1871 and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered, That damages for the land so taken and for the removal of the fences &c be estimated and awarded as follows:

Justin A Jacobs	351 square feet of land 75¢	\$263.25
"	" For the removal of 176 ft of fence 20¢	35.20 \$298.45
Gardner H Thwing	5 square feet of land 75¢	3.75
"	" For the removal of 34 ft of fence 50¢	17.00 <u>20.75</u>
Whole amount-		\$319.20

Ordered, That thirty days be allowed to the persons whose land is taken for said widening, for the removal of their fences.
