WHEREAS: Helene brought a cheerful and pleasant manner to her duties in all the capacities in which she served during her time with the City; now therefore be it

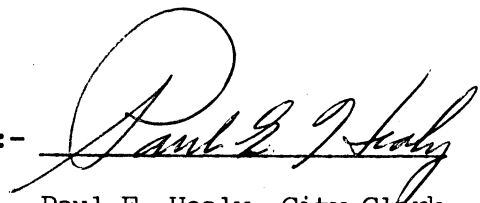
