In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-eight.

An Ordinance
relating to the West Boston and Canal Bridges.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:-

The City of Cambridge hereby determines to assume the ownership, control and charge of the bridges named in the first section of an Act of the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, entitled "an Act authorizing the Hancock Free Bridge Corporation to surrender the West Boston and Canal Bridges to the City of Cambridge", approved by the Governor, on the thirtieth day of May, in the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-seven, as defined in the ninth section of said Act, and upon the terms and conditions set forth in said Act; and the Mayor is hereby authorized, in the name and in behalf of the City of Cambridge, to execute the bond prescribed in the third section of said Act, and to affix the corporate seal of the City thereto, whenever the said Hancock Free Bridge Corporation shall give notice that it is ready to pay over to the City of Cambridge the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, agreeably to the provisions of the fourth section of said Act.
