Purpose:

To share the experience of participants with other practitioners involved in various models of civilian oversight.

To develop an inventory of the models found in locales throughout the North American continent.

Who should attend?

Chief executives of cities, countries, towns, and villages;

Chief police executives and sheriffs;

Elected city and county officials;

Personnel involved in various police accountability units; civilian complaint bureaus, inspectional services bureaus, internal affairs units;

Community organization leaders and members;

Others interested in improving the level of police services.

Conference Overview:

Although there will be some plenary sessions, the primary work of the conference will utilize small group sessions.

Through the use of group reporters, participants will be apprised of the work of the various small groups.

It is anticipated that the conference will conclude with the call for the establishment of a national association of professionals involved in civilian oversight programs

A detailed agenda will be mailed to pre-registrants one week before the start of the conference.

Discussion topics:

1. Community involvement and oversight of police services.
2. The political and administrative mandates and support mechanisms for the civilian oversight process.
3. Criteria for determining priorities for monitoring police conduct and performance.
4. By what means does a City Manager, Mayor, or local legislator determine the quality of police performance.
5. What are the various models for oversight mechanisms.
6. What are community perceptions of civilian oversight.

Speakers:

Hubert Locke: Vice President for Academic Affairs at the University of Washington. Dr. Locke is well qualified and an unusually eloquent speaker. For many years a member of the Board of Directors of the Police Foundation, Dr. Locke has had a sustained and significant interest and involvement with police throughout the United States.

Louis Radelet: Professor Emeritus of Criminal Justice at Michigan State University, Professor Radelet is author of one of the definitive texts on police-community relations. Professor Radelet combines integrity, experience, wisdom and humanistic pragmatism when dealing with the social responsibilities of the police.


