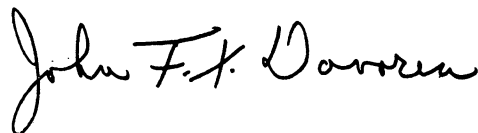

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

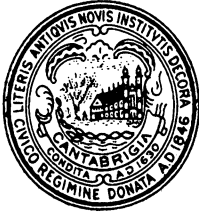

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

As a corporation organized and to be operated exclusively for educational and scientific purposes, to acquire by gift, grant or otherwise money and property of every kind, nature and description, and to administer and use the same and any income or proceeds thereof solely for educational and scientific purposes, to engage in research relating to the psychological, sociological and learning problems related to education, to evaluate, develop and improve programs related to such problems, to train personnel in these areas and to engage in any other activities incidental or consequential to the accomplishment of the foregoing purposes. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder, member or subscriber and no substantial part of its activities shall be carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, by publishing or distributing statements or otherwise, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, its then remaining assets, if any, shall not

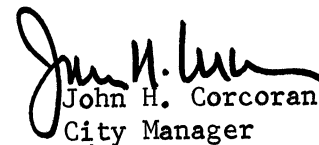
