That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Director of Traffic and Parking on the problem caused by the imposition of boots (booting) of vehicles on Fridays, thereby depriving the owner of the opportunity to pay the fines levied and the use of the vehicle, since the Traffic Department has no one on duty to receive the payment due on weekends, and to further set up a system which will eliminate this problem by having a person available to receive payments.
