- WHEREAS: Mr. Medhia has sustained extensive personal injuries, losing his right leg below the knee and having his left leg shattered; and
- WHEREAS: This unfortunate accident occurred due to an alleged drunk driver who hit the rear of the car which Mr. Medhia was pushing out of the way; and
- WHEREAS: This City Council wishes to officially recognize the good samaritan act of Nega Berhe Medhia and to further extend every good wish for a quick and healthy recuperation to him; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mr. Medhia on behalf of the entire City Council.
