Subject City Council Order #8 of 9/27/89 "Speed Limit on Blanchard Road"

The Traffic Department has conducted speed studies: on both sections of Blanchard Road with a view toward reducing the speed limit. Both times that the study was conducted we found that we could not meet the requirements of the State Department of Public Works and the Registry of Motor Vehicles who must approve any speed regulation.

The present speed limit is 30 MPH which is the state-wide speed allowed in a thickly settled district.

The Department will however conduct another speed study with a view toward reducing the speed limit.
