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The Western Union Telegraph Company having filed with the Department the tariffs above referred to, it is

ORDERED: That the operation of the rates and charges stated therein be suspended and the use thereof deferred until July 15, 1955, unless otherwise ordered by the Department.

FURTHER ORDERED: That a public hearing shall be held as to the propriety of the rates and charges stated therein at its Hearing Room, 166 State House, Boston, on Tuesday, October 5, 1954, at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon.
