In City Council,

ORDERED:-

That the Commissioner of Public Works be requested to grant a permit to Walsh Brothers, Inc. to occupy the sidewalk and three feet of the street at premises No. 94 Prescott Street from _____ to December 31, 1971, and at premises Nos. 5-7-11 Felton Street from March 1, 1972 to September 1, 1972 during the period of construction.

Said permit to be granted subject to the following conditions:-

1. The contractor to erect a barricade of sturdy wooden construction along Prescott and Felton Streets at the above numbered premises during the period of construction to prevent injury or property damage to pedestrians or vehicles using these ways and to provide sufficient lighting and warning signs as required by the Director of Traffic and Parking
2. The owner and contractor to restore the existing sidewalk to the condition it was in prior to the construction or to a better condition.
3. That no existing travel lane shall be closed unless as authorized by the Director of Traffic.
4. That the contractor shall obtain a Temporary Street Construction Permit in addition to all other permits required by the City of Cambridge
5. That the conditions herein specified shall be subject to the approval of the Director of Traffic and Parking of the City of Cambridge who may, as he deems necessary, require traffic controls or the use of policeman to facilitate the flow of traffic.
6. The owner and contractor to file with the City Clerk a bond in the sum of \$10,000 indemnifying the City of Cambridge from any liability that may arise from the construction of said barricade.

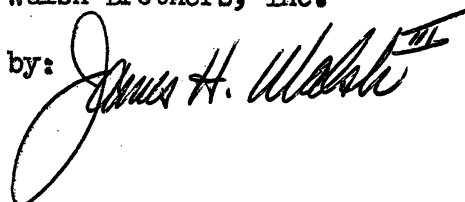
