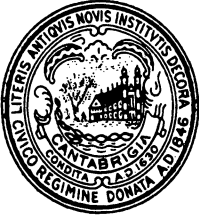

Subject : Private Collection of Household Garbage

The Cambridge Purchasing Department recently received bids for the collection of household garbage as previously discussed. The low bid was from the Cassella Brothers of Waltham, at \$1.75 per household, per week. This cost is less than I anticipated.

I suggest that we inform the City Council and place a notice in the newspaper, that any household that desires private collection notify us and we will make arrangements to have this collection made by Cassella Brothers.

I recommend that these people pay the contractor directly, but we will monitor the collections for the people, and should they have any complaints they can be handled through this office.

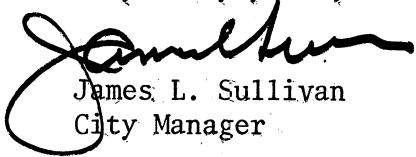
