

# City of Cambridge.

In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred, and  
Seventy six.

An Ordinance in relation to the Fire Department.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the  
City of Cambridge, as follows:

Sect. 1. Each Steam Fire-engine Company appointed by the Mayor and Aldermen shall consist of twelve men; and each Hook & Ladder Company shall consist of seventeen men.

Sect. 2. Hereafter, Steam Fire-engine Companies shall not ballot for Assistant Foremen of their respective Companies; but the Drivers of Hose Carriages shall, in addition to their other duties, perform those required by Section 11 of Chapter 10 of the Revised Ordinances, without extra compensation therefor.

Sect. 3. All Ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent with sections one and two of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.
