TO ALL PERSONS INTERESTED IN THE PRODUCTION, DISTRIBUTION AND CONSUMPTION OF MILK AND CREAM IN ANY AND ALL OF THE SEVERAL MILK MARKETING AREAS IN THE COMMONWEALTH, AND TO ALL OTHER PERSONS INTERESTED:

Notice is hereby given by the Massachusetts Milk Control Commission that, by virtue of the authority vested in it by General Laws Chapter 94A, and more especially pursuant to the provisions contained in Sections 2, 10, 11, 16, 23, 24 and 25 thereof, it will hold a public hearing for all Milk Marketing Areas of the Commonwealth, as follows:

and thereafter at such times and places as the presiding officer may deem necessary for the purpose of receiving from all interested persons testimony and evidence pertinent to the following subjects and issues:

1. Whether or not the Commission should further amend Official Order No. GF-203 as most recently amended effective October 1, 1971 so that the second paragraph of Section 1, under CLASS I MILK PRICE, shall read as follows:

"The Class I price per hundredweight of milk containing 3.5 percent butterfat, for the month shall be \$7.31 plus any amount by which the average price per hundredweight for manufacturing grade milk, f.o.b. plants in Wisconsin and Minnesota, as reported by the U. S. Department of Agriculture for the second preceding month, on a 3.5 percent butterfat basis, exceeds \$4.33."

2. Whether or not the Commission should amend Section 1 of each of Official Orders Nos. G1C269, G2A269, G2B269, G3-269, G7-270, G9-269 so that the last lines of Section 1 beginning with the words U. S. Department of Agriculture, shall read as follows:

--- "U. S. Department of Agriculture for the second preceding month, on a 3.5 percent butterfat basis, exceeds \$4.33. The said additional amount shall be publicly announced for the following month by the fifth day of the preceding month by the Director of Milk Control."

3. Whether or not the Commission should adopt any, and if so, what order or orders or amendments to order or orders relative to the subject matter of Items Nos. 1 & 2.

All persons desiring to be heard or to submit written statements or arguments, or to testify on any subject or matter specified in the hearing notice are hereby notified to appear at the above designated time and place. Copies of all of the above cited Official Orders may be obtained at the Commission's office.
