WHEREAS: The Morse School won Millie from 1991-1993. In addition, Millie basically, singlehandedly, coordinated the science department throughout the City; now therefore be it

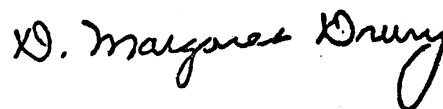
