WHEREAS: The amount of money Cambridge has spent for snow plowing and removal has far exceeded the amount allocated in the FY 94 budget; and

WHEREAS: Lt. Gov. Paul Cellucci informed the Local Government Advisory Committee on Tuesday, February 8, that the Administration would file forthwith a supplementary appropriation for snow and ice with the Legislature to assist local communities throughout the state whose snow budgets are in substantial and growing deficit due to the severity of the winter; and

WHEREAS: The Legislature failed to pass a similar measure in 1993 because the Administration delayed in filing the legislation and because the matter did not arise in the Legislature until August when the weather was hot; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council urge its legislative delegation, Speaker Flaherty, Representatives Thompson and Toomey, and Senators Barrett, Traviglini and Havern as well as Senator Birmingham (whose district will include Cambridge starting in 1995) to press Governor Weld to file this bill immediately and to urge their colleagues to join them in passing this legislation to meet this emergency need as expeditiously as possible.
