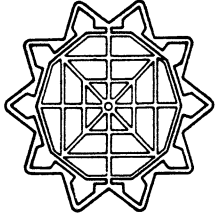

Last Monday the House of Representatives voted 119 to 30 to give initial approval to H-1745 which would reimpose a form of binding arbitration on cities and towns.
