The Committee on Roads and Bridges would submit the following Report on the petition of Geo. Jones et al for improvements on Winthrop St

They find that there is a small strip of land at the Cor of Dunster and Winthrop Sts, some two & one half feet above the level of Winthrop St and contiguous to the same, which renders the street unsafe and dangerous for foot passengers; that said strip is the property of John A. Fulton who is willing to give it to the City to be laid out as a ^{part of the} public highway, provided that the City will make all the repairs to the foundation of his house which are rendered necessary by leveling the said strip of land.

They therefore recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted and that the accompanying order be adopted.
