I was called by a friend today informing me that people in my area want to change the zoning of my house from O to C1.

I am against this for economic reasons.

1. I feel that my house is so close to mass transportation that it is against the interest of the taxpayers of Cambridge to change the zoning.
2. I feel that one should put a ban on changing the character of the houses, so that no highrise should be build which changes the character of Cambridge, which is unique. (Europe attracts tourism because of retaining historical buildings.)
3. We have lived 14½ yrs in this particular house in Cambridge and we feel that by changing the zoning an imposition is caused in view of selling our house.
