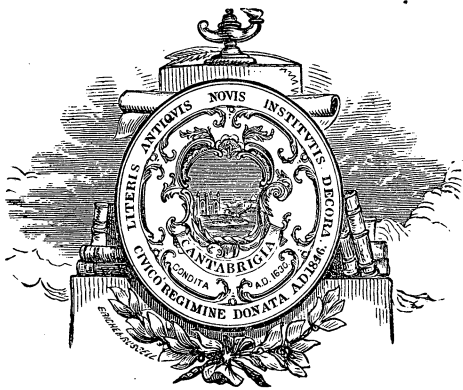




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Oct. 27 1884.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Henry Street,
between Sidney and Waverley Street,

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land

forty feet
in width between *said Sidney and Waverley*
Street

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *Arthur Hodges*
Civil Engineer, dated July 9. 1884,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid,

Said - done for convenience.
