
Painters & Allied Trades District Council #35's Joint Training Program is accepting Apprenticeship Applications at this time. In cooperation with our over 200 union signatory contractors, District Council #35 operates an extensive training program covering painting, taping/drywall finishing, wallcovering, abatement, glass and glazing and sign construction and billboard crafts. Our apprentice training facility is based in Roslindale and accessible by public transportation.

District Council #35 would like to invite you to recommend candidates from your constituency who would be interested in applying for our apprenticeship program. Apprentices work with our signatory contractors during the day and attend classes at least two nights a week from September to April. This opportunity to both earn and learn offers young women and men the chance to acquire a skill and a trade that can last a lifetime.

Candidates are accepted into our apprenticeship program by meeting the entrance requirements outlined on the enclosed sheet as well as completing an interview and passing a drug test. No candidate is guaranteed acceptance into the District Council #35 Joint Training Program however, recommendations from elected officials are considered during the interview process.

I have enclosed an Apprenticeship Application for your use. The deadline for applications is January 31, 2001.
