The Committee on Roads and Bridges
would respectfully
Report

That, in pursu-
ance of an Order of the City Council, the
Committee has conferred with the Selectmen
of Waterbury and the Trustees of the Auburn
Cemetery, in relation to grading Coolidge Av-
enue, so called, leading to the Cambridge
Cemetery. The fee of the Avenue is in the
Cemetery Corporation of the Auburn, and
the Trustees consent to the proposed altera-
tion, and will pay \$2500 of the cost of
making it. The Selectmen of Waterbury
assent to the alteration and have agreed
to insert an article in the Warrant for
the next town meeting for voting upon the
question of the payment of a like sum by
Waterbury. The Committee would unanim-
ously recommend the adoption of the Order
herewith submitted.
