An Ordinance,
establishing the Salaries of sundry City Officers.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows:-

The Officers of the City, hereinafter named,
shall receive the following annual salaries, to be
paid in equal quarterly payments, which shall be
in full for all services rendered in their official ca-
-pacity:

City Treasurer, one hundred and fifty dollars:

City Clerk, exclusive of Fees established by
Law, three hundred and twenty-five dollars:

Clerk of the Common Council, one hun-
-dred dollars:

Board of Assessors, five hundred dollars:

Chief Engineer, one hundred dollars:

Four Assistant Engineers, twenty-five dol-
-lars, each.
