

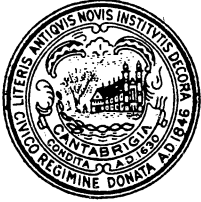

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is a request to accept and appropriate \$249,290 to the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Service Programs Other Ordinary Maintenance account. These funds have been allocated by the Executive Office of Communities and Development for administration of the 1982-83 Low-Income Fuel Assistance Program in this area. Current projections at the State level earmark \$2.5 million dollars for fuel payments during the upcoming winter season (October 1, 1982 - April 30, 1983).

The administrative budget for the program supports a short-term staff of seventeen individuals whose responsibilities include outreach, receipt of applications, negotiation with fuel dealers on behalf of eligible clients, verification of client eligibility, processing of payments, and management of appeals. Also included in administrative costs are funds to support contractual arrangements covering outreach and intake services with the City of Somerville, Somerville Cambridge Elder Services, and Concilio Hispano. Finally, these funds also support such non-personnel items as data processing, printing and reproduction, supplies, telephone and postage costs.

Passage of this request is recommended.
