SUBJECT: Response to Council Order #50-dated 03/04/91

DATE: 26 March 1991

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The City has submitted, and the Department of Personnel Administration has agreed to process a requisition from the City to reestablish the Police Reserve List, and to appoint 18 individuals from that list to reserve police positions. This step is the best available means to protect the investment made in the recent screening of police applicants.

In terms of summer coverage, the Police Commissioner and his command staff will have the opportunity to carefully review staffing requirements, and may make use of increased shift designation flexibility, assignment adjustments, and judicious use of overtime to ensure adequate staffing.
