COUNCILLOR GRAHAM

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to draft a proposal to the Civilian Defense Department of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to provide for the funding of educational literature which would inform our citizens of the effects of nuclear warfare on the survivors, the impossibility of successful evacuation and the necessity of freezing the stockpiling of nuclear weapons and to direct the efforts of our government toward peaceful solutions of our differences; and be it further

ORDERED: That this educational program be instituted in our schools to make our school children realize that there are no winners in nuclear warfare, just devastation and indescribable harm to our environment and to the health and well-being of our city, state and country.
