Haley, Jr. Passengers along that route have a right to know that bus #69 will be where it is scheduled to be as it makes its stops along Cambridge Street; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager direct this complaint to Mr. Haley with the request that the latter specify what steps will be taken immediately to remedy the problem. Further, that the City Manager report back to the City Council on this matter within two weeks.
