- WHEREAS: This City Council has learned that Liam C. Harney, an eighteen year old Xaverian High School student from Walpole, won the "1984 World's Champion Irish Step Dancer" Award during an international competition held in Cork City, County Cork, Ireland, this past April; and
- WHEREAS: Liam has spent most of his young life in the pursuit of this goal, a dream he had for a long time, one which was fulfilled only through his perseverance, self-discipline and a willingness to strive for perfection; and
- WHEREAS: Liam was recently honored by some 650 friends, relatives and well wishers at a reception in his honor on May 13th at the Irish Social Club of Boston, where he received the recognition of many individuals, civic and political leaders, including President Ronald Reagan, who sent a telegram indicating Liam had been chosen as a "Presidential Scholar" for "significant achievement in the area of performing arts"; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere congratulations to Liam Harney, World Champion Irish Step Dancer and to further extend every good wish for all his future endeavors; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Liam on behalf of the entire City Council.

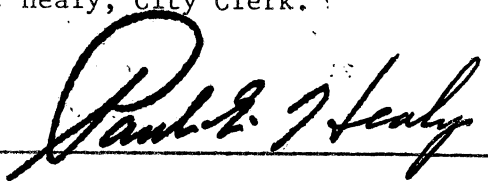
