
MAYOR RUSSELL

- WHEREAS: Public safety of the residents of the City of Cambridge, and of the visitors to the City of Cambridge, is of the utmost concern to the Cambridge City Council; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge wishes to comply with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts' Building Code and the Architectural Barriers Regulations concerning curb cuts at crosswalks to facilitate access to public buildings and grounds by the handicapped; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to inspect the curb cuts on all current construction in the City that need to be in compliance with the Architectural Barriers Regulations; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to inspect the curb cuts on all construction work that has been completed since the mandates of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts' Building Code and Architectural Barriers Regulations concerning the handicapped have been in effect.
