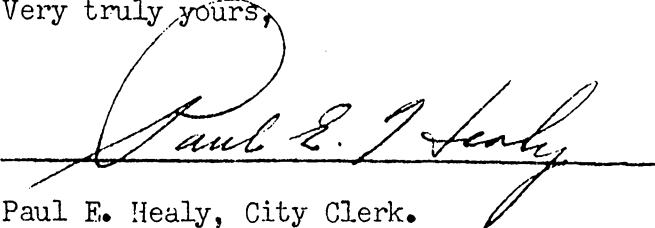
Dear Neighborhood Representative:

Your kind cooperation in this matter will be greatly appreciated by the members of the City Council.

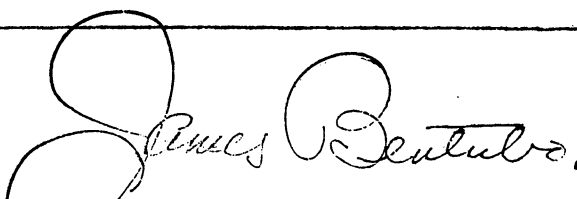

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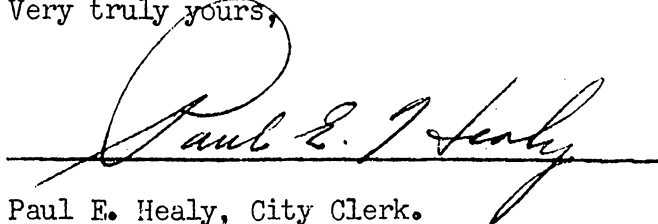
