- WHEREAS: Dolores first entered the employ of the City on October 15, 1954 as a provisional Junior Clerk-Stenographer assigned to the Recreation Department, where she worked for many years until the creation in 1980 of the Department of Human Services, to which she was transferred and ultimately promoted to the position from which she will retire; and
- WHEREAS: Dolores was active in Union activities within the City, serving as a Steward in Local 195 of the Public Employees Union and working on behalf of the clerical workers at City Hall; and
- WHEREAS: Dolores will be missed by her colleagues and friends for her sage advice over the years; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere best wishes to Dolores M. Bulkowski as she completes nearly twenty-nine years of dedicated service to the City of Cambridge; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Dolores on behalf of the entire City Council.
