ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to take the necessary steps to increase the visibility of the existing sign indicating Speridakis Terrace is a dead end street whose presence is blocked by tree branches; and be it further

ORDERED: That a new traffic sign calling for CAUTION/CHILDREN or SLOW or a flashing yellow signal, be installed as soon as possible in an effort to decrease the risk to children's safety especially as summer vacation begins; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to the Council on this matter by June 24, 1991.
