COUNCILLOR SULLIVAN

WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of the City Council that Genzyme has chosen a site in Boston for the development of a \$75 million manufacturing plant over the city of Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: The media has also announced the cut back of positions and the possible relocation of Lotus Development Corporation; and

WHEREAS: The continued inability of the City of Cambridge to maintain and attract commercial development will have a direct adverse impact on the revenue of the City of Cambridge as indicated by the City Manager at the Finance Committee meeting held on Tuesday, December 3, 1991 where the City Manager indicated that building fees are off 85%; therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to immediately appoint an advisory committee, comprised of administration officials, representative of the construction industry, the development community, the business community in an effort to develop a comprehensive economic development plan to maintain and attract development in the City of Cambridge while also maintaining the quality of life for the residents of Cambridge.
