

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, June 12 1838.

Ordered,

That the Superintendent of Streets be directed to set Granite circles and return stones in the streets hereinafter named. The expense thereof to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department (Paving), and assessed upon the abutters in just proportions in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 191 of the acts of the year 1863. - viz: -

Granite circles and return stones.

On the south-westerly corner of Concord avenue and Sparks Street. *Done*

On the south easterly corner of De Wolfe and Otter Streets.

On the north westerly corner of De Wolfe and Otter Streets.

On the south side of Linnaean Street at the entrance of the new street called Gray Street, on both corners. *Done*
