WHEREAS, in the matter of return of the County Commissioners of
December 13, 1966 for the specific repairs of Massachusetts Avenue,
Pine Street, Washington Street, Blakeslee Street and Charles Street in
said Cambridge, it appears that John L. Danehy, County Commissioners,
is a resident of the City of Cambridge and therefore unable to act on
the petition of the inhabitants of the City of Cambridge for the re-
location and specific repairs of Massachusetts Avenue, Pine Street,
Washington Street, Blakeslee Street and Charles Street, in said
Cambridge.

Now, therefore, we, Frederick J. Connors and John F. Dever, Jr.,
County Commissioners, and Edward J. Sullivan, Clerk of the Courts, do
hereby appoint John E. Shaughnessy, of Stoneham, in said County, to act
in the stead of the said John L. Danehy in the matter of said petition
until such disqualification ceases - in accordance with the provisions
of Section 12, Chapter 34, General Laws .

At a meeting of the County Commissioners for the County of Middlesex, holden at **Lowell**, within and for said County, on the first Tuesday of **September**, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and **sixty-six**

The inhabitants of the City of Cambridge,

in said County, by **their** petition to said Commissioners—among other matters—pray **that Massachusetts Avenue, Pine Street, Washington Street, Blakeslee Street, and Charles Street, in said Cambridge, may be specifically repaired,**

as will more fully appear, reference being had to the petition filed of record in the case.

The petition was presented to the County Commissioners at their meeting holden at **Cambridge**, within and for said County, on the first Tuesday of **June**, A.D. 19 **66**, when and where notice was ordered given to all persons and corporations interested therein of the time and place when and where said Commissioners would meet for the purpose of viewing the premises and hearing the parties as by their order of notice on file and of record will more fully appear.

And, at the time of said view and hearing, said specific repairs were adjudged of public convenience and necessity;

And, at a meeting holden at Cambridge, within and for said County, on the first Tuesday of June, 1966, said Commissioners directed specific repairs on said ways, as appears herein;

Thence said petition has been continued to this time.

And now the said Commissioners make **partial** return of their proceedings in the premises, as follows: said Commissioners having given notice as the law directs, met at **the Superior Court House** in said **Cambridge**, on the **seventeenth** day of **August**, in the year nineteen hundred and **sixty-six**, when and where the parties appeared, to wit, the petitioner **s by Ralph J. Dunphy, Commissioner of Public Works for the City of Cambridge;** and no parties appeared to object. ********* by

The premises having been examined, and the parties fully heard, said Commissioners

proceeded to direct that Massachusetts Avenue, Pine Street, Washington Street, Blakeslee Street and Charles Street, in the said City of Cambridge, be specifically repaired, in accordance with a future estimate and design to be prepared by the Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and a future Memorandum of Agreement to be made between the said City of Cambridge and said Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth - copies of said Agreement, design and estimate to be filed in the office of said Commissioners; the said Commissioners expressly reserving for a future return description of the manner and limits of the said specific repairs of said ways upon the execution of said future Memorandum of Agreement therefor.

AND, whereas it appears that the Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the City Manager of the City of Cambridge have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding number 297 dated October 19, 1966, whereby the said Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth agrees to set aside the sum of \$74,000 for the purpose of such work - subject to monies being appropriated by the General Court for Chapter 90 projects; said Memorandum of Understanding being also subject to future contract for the proposed work; and whereas it appears that the estimated cost of the said work is \$148,000 and the City has available \$37,000.;

Now, therefore, said Commissioners do hereby direct that upon the completion of the work to be hereinafter described by future return of said Commissioners to the acceptance and satisfaction of said Commissioners and said Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth, the County shall pay to the said City of Cambridge one-fourth ($1/4$) of the cost of the work done, but not exceeding the sum of Thirty-Seven Thousand Dollars (\$37,000.).

In this matter, John E. Shaughnessy, of Stoneham, acted in place of John L. Danehy, County Commissioner, under the provisions of Section 12, Chapter 34, General Laws - said John L. Danehy, being disqualified to act in said matter due to residence in said City of Cambridge.

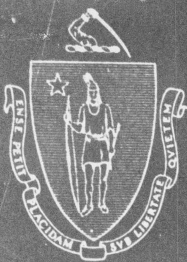

The Department and the City/Town agrees that this Memorandum of Understanding is subject to a future contract for the proposed project(s) which will be drawn up by the Department and approved by both parties.
