- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of **Michael McKenna** at this time of such personal loss; and be it further

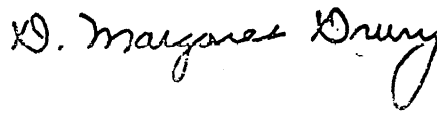
RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the McKenna family on behalf of the entire City Council.
