WHEREAS:-

By sundry orders of the City Council adopted on March 24th, March 31st, April 7th, April 21st, April 28th and May 5th, 1931 the Superintendent of Streets was authorized to grant sundry permits for the erection of swing arms and signs, provided that the petitioners file a bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) each conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said swing arms and signs, it is hereby

ORDERED:-

That the aforesaid orders be amended by changing the amount of the bond required in each case from the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) to Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00).
