An Ordinance
Establishing the Salary of the City Engineer

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows

Section I. That the Salary of the City Engineer be, and hereby is established at the rate of one thousand eight hundred dollars a year; which sum shall be paid to him in equal quarterly payments, and shall be in full for all services rendered to the City, not only by himself, but by all persons employed by him, and for all the incidental expenses of his office.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge

~~That the following Section be, it is hereby a portion of the Ordinance establishing the Office of City Engineer Section -~~

In the month of April 1868, and in the month of January in each year thereafter, there shall be appointed a joint Committee of the City Council, to be called the Committee on the Engineer's Department, to consist of One member of the Board of Aldermen, and two members of the Common Council. The said Committee shall have the care and supervision of the City Engineer's Office; and the appointment and discharge of all persons employed therein shall be with their approval; and they shall fix the amount of Compensation to be paid to said employes respectively.
