Gentlemen;

The Board of Park Commissioners at its meeting on March 21st, received the following orders and beg to report;

On order dated March 15, 1938, requesting removal of a tree standing on front of 11 Waterhouse Street; the Board sees no reason for removal of a public shade tree standing in the sidewalk in front of 11 Waterhouse Street.

On order dated March 8, 1938, requesting restoration of a club house and children's slides at John J. Ahern Field; the Board deems such action inadvisable.

On order dated March 8, 1938, relative to a date on which the wooden seats will be placed on the concrete bleachers at Cambridge Field; the Board is unable to state when the seats will be placed, but can say that this is one of several items of a W.P.A., Project being written at this time.

On order dated March 8, 1938, relative to erection of rail fence between the grounds of the Rindge Technical School and the Public Library; the Board has already submitted figures for such erection in a consolidated W.P.A. Project.

On order dated March 8, 1938, relative to dredging around the raft at Magazine Beach; the Board will communicate with the Metropolitan District Commission to this effect.
