To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$803,659.00 in the Grant Fund of the Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$104,073.00) and the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$699,586.00) from the Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development. The Cambridge/Somerville Low Income Heating Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is operated by the Department of Human Services and serves 3,200 clients in both cities including 1,400 Cambridge residents. Benefit levels this year will range from \$40.00 to \$360.00 per client depending on income level and household characteristics. These funds will be used to provide administration of the program and to provide benefits.
