IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Dec. 20 1882

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that *Garfield Street, so-called, extending from North Avenue to Oxford Street,*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *fifty feet* in width between *North Avenue and Oxford Street,*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *Charles Merton* and dated *Nov. 25, 1882.*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the* several owners and abutters on said street, having waived all claims for such damages.
