**CITY OF CAMBRIDGE
In the Year One Thousand,
Nine Hundred Seventy-Eight
AN ORDINANCE**

In amendment to an ordinance
entitled: "The Zoning Ordinances
of the City of Cambridge".

Be it ordained by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge as follows:

The Zone Map accompanying
ordinance passed to be ordained
September 26, 1977 entitled: "The
Zoning Ordinance of the City of
Cambridge" is hereby amended by
adding a new section 11.32 which
reads as follows:

11.32 Establishments seeking to
relocate their existing operations
inside the boundary line of the
Zoning district in which the
establishment is located shall not
be required to obtain a special
permit if any of the following
conditions will be met.

11.321 The new site shall be
within 500 feet of the original site of
the establishment.

11.322 There will be no increase
in the gross floor area of the
establishment at the new site.

11.323 Establishments with 1750
square feet or less of gross floor
area and with not more than five
employees within a twenty-four
hour period shall be exempt from
the provisions of the Zoning Or-
dinances which pertains to Fast
Food Establishments.
