In Board of Aldermen, <sup>april 24, 1871.</sup> ~~March 15, 1871.~~

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that a certain private street, called Alleston Street, should be laid out as a public street or way, from Brookline Street Northwesterly to its present terminus, and thence in the same direction to Clearys Street.

Therefore Ordered, That the land required for the extension of said street to Clearys Street be taken for this purpose, and that said street be laid out as a public street or way, by the name of Alleston Street, from Brookline Street to Clearys Street, the same to be forty feet in width, as delineated on a Plan drawn by W. A. Cleaves & C. S. Elliot, dated March 8, 1871, and now before this Board.

Ordered, That damages for the land so taken and for the injury to buildings and other property be estimated and awarded as follows:

George F. Cleaves for 10.68 square feet  
of land taken, at 20<sup>cts</sup> / 213.60  
for moving buildings, repairs  
and damages, 1400.00
