Investigation by the Department on its own motion as to the propriety of the rates and charges set forth in Schedule M.D.P.U. No. 206 - Rate Adjustment, filed with the Department on November 11, 1974 to become effective on December 1, 1974, by the Cambridge Electric Light Company.

The Company having filed the schedule referred to above, this Department suspended the operation and use of the rates and charges set forth therein pending investigation and study of the propriety. The proposed rate increase would, if approved, raise additional annual revenues of approximately \$3,767,000, with the Company requesting emergency interim rate relief in the amount of \$2,218,000.

Pending its investigation and study as to the propriety of the proposed rates, the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing as to the granting of the requested emergency interim rate relief at its hearing room, #1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Mass., on Wednesday, December 11, 1974, at 11:00 o'clock in the forenoon.
