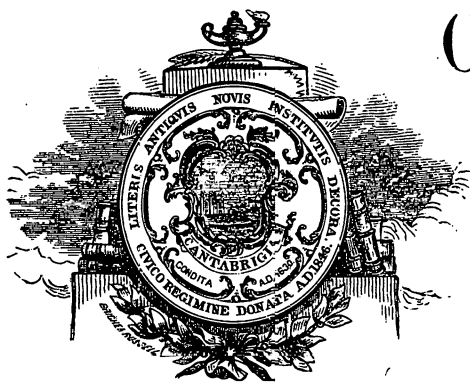


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Dec. 28, 1874.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Lake Street

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land in width between

Forty feet
Magazine and Pearl Streets

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

W. S. Barbour and A. Hodges
dated December 1874.

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *And*
That thirty days be allowed for the removal of all
obstructions standing thereon
sent and for commenced.
