- WHEREAS: Kay first began her career working as a Secretary for government agencies in New York and Boston and in 1952 was appointed as a Clerk-Stenographer for the Cambridge Hospital and later transferred to the School Department and was promoted to a Principal Clerk and later served as an Administrative Assistant to the Superintendent of Schools, a position she held from 1979 until the time of her death; and
- WHEREAS: Kay loved life and enjoyed participating in various City-sponsored activities, as well as being truly devoted to her two daughters and three grandchildren; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Kay's entire family at this time of such deep personal loss; and be it further
