

Public Record "no more no shoveling tickets" 4/14/97 Peter Valentine

Regarding the unconstitutionality of giving citizens tickets for not shoveling public areas. Amendment 13 "No involuntary servitude".

I have lived where I am now for 6 years and have always taken great pleasure in shoveling two long sidewalks even reshoveling the exit areas where the city's trucks pile snow back onto the areas I've shoveled.
