- WHEREAS: Herman held various positions throughout his life serving as Administrative Chairman of the Cambridge United Way, National Field Director for the Red Cross during World War II with the armed services and as a National Field Representative from 1942 to 1958 as well as serving as Director of the Red Cross Hungarian Relief Programs at Camp Kilmer in New Jersey; and
- WHEREAS: Herman Siegel has spent a life time trying to help those in need regardless of the individuals plight, a job he had done with excellence over the years; now therefore be it
