ORDERED: That M.I.T. acknowledge the grave error which occurred on August 7, 1982 when waste materials were accidentally dumped into a compactor and some of the liquid material was allowed to flow into a nearby drain that eventually found it's way into the City storm drain and finally, into the Charles River, thereby contributing to the pollution of the river; and be it further

ORDERED: That M.I.T. be requested to announce it's plan publicly to keep this from ever happening again.
