IN CITY COUNCIL

ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to The Athenaeum Group for the erection of an address sign-entry canopy to One Kendall Square.

Provided that, before erecting the above named address sign-entry canopy petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.) Dollars, - conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said address sign-entry canopy.

(State whether Electric or otherwise and material used in construction)

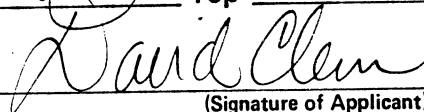
Reading matter to go on sign: One Kendall Square; Tenant Directory; Retail Shops as shown on attached plan.

Size: Total canopy 18' x 18' high pyramid of which one corner (9.5 x 9.5 x 7.0) projects over sidewalk

Weight: Approx. 1800 lbs.

How Erected: A: 7' -8" B: 10' -0"
(A: Give exact distance sign is to extend from building over sidewalk.)
(B: Also exact distance from bottom of sign to sidewalk.)

Height Above Grade: Bottom 10' -0" Top 17' -0"
